Family: Son of Presley Goodman Ballard and May Bond. He was one of nine children.

Military: Clarence served as a Private in the US Army during WWI as military police. He was with 65th Co in the 17th Batallion – 165th Depot. He enlisted on 25 Jun 1918 and was discharged on 19 Mar 1919.

Civilian: The 1950 Census finds Clarence and Naomi living in Fort Worth, Texas. They resided in Ft. Worth at least 30 years. During his early years, Ballard was an oil field worker. Later in life, Ballard is shown to be a retail merchant at a grocery store. He operated stores in both Ft. Worth and Austin. He was a member of the Birdville Church of Christ.
