His WW II Registration Draft Card lists him as 5 ft 10 ½ inches, weighing 174 pounds with gray eyes, brown hair and a dark complexion. He is shown in a muster roll of the Crew for the USS *ABSD* on 3 June 1944. He enlisted on 5 September 1942 and came aboard on 10 November 1943. He remained on muster rolls through 9 November 1945, when he was shown on the US *Bennington* awaiting notification of the next station.
