In his obituary, Charles Winfield Phipps of Dallas, is recognized as being a World War II Navy veteran. He is listed as a retired heavy-equipment mechanic. His World War II Draft Registration Card lists him as 5 ft 6½ inches, weighing 153 pounds with blue eyes, blonde hair and light complexion. He enlisted on 26 Aug 1942 and was discharged a few days later on the 29th, according to the Department of Veterans Affairs BIRLS Death file. No other records of his service have been found.
