John Edward Robinson, III was born in Erie, Erie County, Pennsylvania on 20 Nov 1924 to John E. Robinson, II and Irene M. Kinsell. When John registered for the draft on 26 Dec 1942, he was a resident of Shaker Heights, Ohio. John served as a HA1 (Hospital Apprentice 1st Class) in the U.S. Navy.

John married Jean Delores Collins (1930-2018) on 20 Oct 1951 in Detroit, Michigan. His headstone, located in Flower Mound Cemetery, Flower Mound, TX, is inscribed with the words "*Beloved Husband, Dad, and Grandpa*". John passed away on 12 Jan 2015 in Highland Village, Denton County, Texas.
