Military: Eddie served his country during the Vietnam War and was in the US Navy, from 1961 to 1964. He served as an AMH 3 – Aviation Structural Mechanic Third Class.

Civilian: Eddie was employed by Western Transfer Company in Grand Prairie as a vice president. He was murdered by an employee who was disputing a payment issue. Along with Eddie, 5 others were killed by this same individual. He died in 1982, and cause of death was murder with a handgun. Eddie was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Lewisville.
