Man Dies Following Shooting

A 37-year-old man died at about 1:30 a.m. Tuesday in Flow Memorial Hospital from wounds he received in a shooting incident earlier Monday night.

According to police reports, a motorist found a wounded **John H. Peace**, 37, of 704 Chambers shortly before midnight Monday lying by his car in the 1000 block of Duncan. A shotgun was lying next to his body, police were told.

When police officers arrived at the scene, Peace told them he had accidentally shot himself as he climbed from his car, police reports said.

Peace was taken to Flow hospital and died at 1:25 a.m. Tuesday. An autopsy has been ordered in the case, hospital officials said.

Funeral services for **John H. Peace**, 37, of 704 Chambers, are pending at People's Funeral Home.

Mr. Peace died Monday at Flow Memorial Hospital.

He was born Oct. 31, 1938, in Denton. He was a veteran of Vietnam. He married **Beulah Gamble** Nov. 10, 1956, in Denton.

Survivors include his wife, **Beulah** of Denton; his parents, Mr. and Mrs. **Willie Peace** of Denton; one daughter, **Carliss Peace** of Denton; three sons, **John Peace Jr.**, **Jeffery Lyle Peace** and **Stephen J. Peace**, all of Denton; one sister, **Edna Sue Miles** of Denton; one brother, **Willie L. Peace** of Denton; and his grandmother, **Pearl Haynes** of Denton.
