Military: In June 1945, entered the United States Army as one of 39 Denton County men called to serve that month. Military service continued and concluded with his honorable discharge in December 1946.

Civilian: Graduated from Denton High School in May 1936. As a teenager, worked long hours on the family farm along Justin-Krum Road, gaining the agricultural skills that would shape his life. Following his wartime service, he returned to the family dairy farm and participated in the Justin Veterans Agriculture Class, a program designed to help returning veterans develop new skills, including butchering and meat curing, orchard pruning, and electrical wiring. James remained connected to the farming community until his death in 1984.

Family: James never married. He remained on the family farm, where he lived with his mother and aunt, and was remembered in the community as a kind and helpful neighbor.
