Military: Enlisted in the United States Army in September 1942 as one of 88 Denton County men called to military service that month.
In May 1945, awarded the Bronze Star for efficiency, bravery, courage, and devotion to duty while serving in combat with the Fifth Army in Italy.
Ultimately attained the rank of Warrant Officer
Military service concluded with his honorable discharge in December 1953.

Civilian: As a teenager, showed horses at local fairs, earning second place at the 1937 Denton County Fair for his colt.
Following wartime service, returned to farming and spent the remainder of his life as a farmer.

Family: Jack married Golda Ann Pockrus in 1947. They had a daughter and two sons together.
