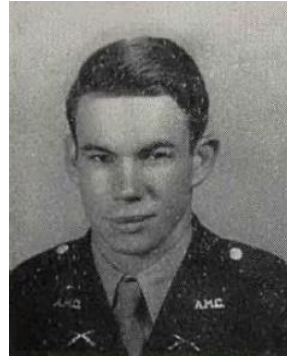

Military: Jim served his country during both the Korean and the Vietnam Wars. He enlisted in the U.S. Army on 28 May 1951 and was discharged on 27 Feb 1953. He later retired as a Lt. Colonel from the U.S. Army Reserves.

Civilian: Jim was a graduate of Texas A & M and was described as an "Aggie" to the end. As a civilian, he was employed as a Rural Route Mail Carrier in Argyle for 32 years before his retirement in 1985. Jim was active in Boy Scouts, a member of Optimist International, a member of the American Legion, and a life-long member of the Argyle United Methodist Church.

Family: Jim was the firstborn child of John Pennington Heath and Grace Mae McMakin. He was married to Norma Jean Simpson in Houston on 15 Aug 1947. Jim and Norma were the parents of two sons. Norma preceded him in death; they lie together in Prairie Mound Cemetery.
