Military: William was a PVT in the 512th Motor Transport Corps of the U.S. Army, where he served from 15 Jun 1918 to 12 Feb 1919. The 512th was a part of the American Expeditionary Forces and was instrumental in the logistical movement of troops, ammunition, and supplies.

Civilian: William worked as a mail carrier for the U.S. Post Office for 30 years in Electra, Texas. He was a member of the Masonic Lodge of Electra and the Methodist Church.

Family: William married Winifred Bell at age 23: two sons, Charles Lagrone and William Scotty. On 01 Jan 1930 at the age of 37, he was married to Barbara Angerer in Bridgetown, Oklahoma. William is buried next to his son Carl, sharing a headstone. His other son, William Scotty, also lies In Prairie Mound Cemetery.
