Military: Loyd was a Sergeant in the U.S. Army Air Force during WW II. He served in the 403rd Troop Carrier Group and the 13th Troop Carrier Squadron. He enlisted on 11 Apr 1942 and was discharged on 14 Apr 1946.

Civilian: Loyd worked as a gravel truck driver to support his family.

Family: Loyd's parents were John Clay Rodgerson and Temple Crawford.
On 10 Nov 1952 Loyd was married to Willie Jo Griffith in Denton, Texas.
The couple had one daughter, Loydia Joan.
On each side of Loyd's grave there is evidence of an unmarked grave. It is believed that one of the graves holds Willie Jo and the other holds Loydia Joan.
