Military: Bill enlisted in the U.S. Navy on 26 Mar 1945 and served until discharged on 24 Jul 1946. His naval rank was F1, Fireman 1st Class.

Civilian: Bill graduated from North Texas State College and Southwestern Baptist Seminary. In 1963 he began a ministry as the music/youth minister at First Baptist Church of Denton. He served there until 1992 when he retired. After retirement Bill and his wife enjoyed travel on mission trips with the church choirs, camping in Colorado, floating the Comal River, and spending time in national parks.

Family: Bill's parents were William Terrance Shadle and Mattie Maye Brooks. His family included siblings Alice Beth and Ralph Albert. On 3 Mar 1951 Bill married Maxine Tankursley in Truth or Consequences, New Mexico. They were married for 53 years.
