Military: John was a LtCol (Lieutenant Colonel) in the U.S. Marine Corps during WW II. He completed his advanced Navy Air Corps training at Corpus Christi, Texas, and was afterwards transferred to the Marine Corps.

Civilian: When John registered for the draft in 1940, he lived in Ventura, California, working for Bank of America as a cashier.

Family: John's parents were Charles Richard Shaw and Clara Jane Barker. His siblings included Charles, Ralph, Patricia, and half-sister Clara Jane. In 1942 John married Lois Tallman in Ventura, California. Late in life, John married Josephine "Jo" Aldinger in Denton, Texas. She and John share a headstone at Prairie Mound Cemetery.
