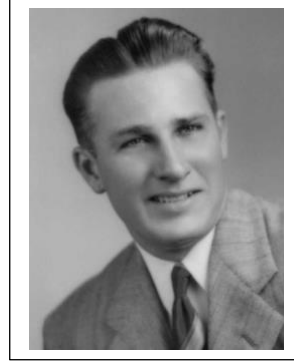

Military: Tommy served as a U.S. Army paratrooper in the Asian Pacific during WW II after his enlistment on 21 May 1943. His rank was Private.

Civilian: He worked in pipeline construction and offshore oil drilling rigs in the U.S. and many foreign countries.

Family: Tommy was the son of Perry Radar and Beulah Agnes Runyan; one sister and one brother. He was married to Doris Martin in 1948 and to Mary Morein Miller in 1964. At the time of his death, he had 2 children, 3-stepchildren, 11 grandchildren; 14 great-grandchildren.
