Military: Perry enlisted in the U.S. Army to fight in WW I on 03 Jul 1917.
Discharged on 02 Apr 1919. He attained the rank of Corporal.

Civilian: During his lifetime Perry was employed as a farmer, a night watchman, and as a custodian in the Argyle, TX school district.

Family: Perry was the son of Joseph Richard Wood and an unknown mother.
His mother died before he was 10 and his father died when Perry was just 12 years old.
Perry had one sister, Minnie Lee.
On 30 Apr 1921 Perry was married to Clela Mae Lynch in Denton, TX.
The couple had son Perry Addison and daughter Greta Dean.
