Military: Enlisted 17 Aug 1942 as a Warrant Officer in the US Army. Served in WWII in the Eighth Air Force, 92nd Bomber Group, in the European and North Africa Theatres. He was discharged in 1946 and returned to service in 1948, joining the US Air Force. He was sent to the B-36 engine power plant school, and in 1949 completed a course on jet engines. Charles served as a Tech Sgt in the US Air Force in Korea. He retired as an aircraft mechanic of the US Air Force.

He was the grandson of Mrs. Rachel Robertson Hawk, a pioneer resident in the Chinn Chapel community. She came to Denton County in 1861 and lived for over 65 years in that community where she married William Hawk and raised eight children.
