Family: Son of Andrew Danley and Jane Inman. Ira married Nancy Cathey Allen in 1847 in Rusk County, Texas. Children were Elizabeth Danley (Vaughn) and Eliza Alice Danley (Grigg). However, there is some question because their births are listed 18 years apart on FAG. In that 1850 Census, it shows a daughter Mary just 2 years younger than Elizabeth. They also had a son, William Joseph Danley.

Military: Mexican War, Private, First Texas Foot Riflemen. Ira enlisted in Rusk County and served 29 Jun 1846.

Civilian: The 1850 Census shows the Danley (aka Dannely) family living in Smith County, Texas as a farmer. At the 04 Nov 1856 election, Mr. Danley was elected as Commissioner No. 4 in Denton County with James Buchanan as President
