Family: Hamilton was the son of William Noah Jarnigan and Elizabeth Emily Sharp. On July 6, 1868, he married Grizelda Orlena Kirby. In 1870, they had one son, William.

Military: Hamilton enlisted on Jan 15, 1862, in Alabama as a Sergeant and mustered out in 1865. He was in Company B with the 49th Alabama Infantry

Civilian: They started their family on a farm in Perreys, Alabama according to the 1870 Census. The 1880 Census finds the family of 3 also living on a farm. By 1900, they own their farm in Precinct 3, Denton County, Texas.
