

## Remember Them Forever

Name: Malcolm Jordan McNeill  
Birth: March 24, 1837

Death: March 25, 1917

Cemetery: Chinn's Chapel Cemetery  
Cemetery Location: Copper Canyon, Denton County, Texas, USA

Family: Married Fannie Mary Elizabeth Kincade on 6 Oct 1866 in Tennessee. They had five children: David Edward, Robert Lee, Landon H, Jacob S, and Ida Lou. The 1850 Census (Lawrence County, TN) finds Malcolm as a teen living with his father, Hugh McNeil from Scotland and his siblings.

Military: Malcolm enlisted on 9 July 1861 in Tennessee. He served for four years with the Tennessee Infantry. He was in Company B, 23<sup>rd</sup> Regiment. McNeill became a Sergeant with Martin's Regiment. The majority of the 23<sup>rd</sup> regiment mustered out on 9 April 1865 in Tennessee.

Civilian: MJ moved to Denton County, Texas in 1884. 1907 finds him still living in Denton County as a farmer but applying for a pension due to not being able to work any longer. At the time, he owned 2 horses, 3 cows and calves – all for a total worth of \$250.
