Family: Neal is the son of Mary Rebecca Shaw. Neal was married to Sarah on 7 Sept 1871 in Dallas County, Texas. They had six children according to the 1880 census: Robert, Anna, Marion, Lizzie, Mattie, and Willie.

Military: Mr. Shaw enlisted on March 8, 1862, at Palmetto, Mississippi, and was paroled in June 1865 in Memphis Tennessee. He served with Company G, 31st Mississippi Infantry as a Private under Capt. John Manahan.

Civilian: In 1870, the census shows us that Neal is a farmer in Texas with three other Shaw men.
