He registered on 16 Oct 1940. His height was 5 ft 8 inches, weight 180, with brown eyes and hair and a dark complexion. The *Denton Record-Chronicle* on 14 January 1944 lists him as one of 74 (seventy-four) men that were accepted into the armed services, and in his case, the Army. His discharge date of 1 February 1946 comes from the Department of Veteran Affairs BIRLS Death file.

Civilian: The World War II Draft Registration Card offers his employee as W.H. Holloway in Denton. At death, he was the owner of a service station.
