Family: In April 1846, married Jane Tidd in Upson, Georgia. Three years later they had a son, Francis M. Looking at the 1880 Census, it appears Anderson was married to Nancy, still residing in Georgia.

Military: Enlisted on 15 Jun 1861. Discharged on 20 Mar 1863.
Served during the Civil War as a Private with Company K, 12th Georgia Infantry.

Civilian: Farmer. In 1854, in Marion Georgia. On March 2, 1867, found in the ledger for 'Returns of Qualified Voters and Reconstruction Oath Books', which is titled "an act to provide for the more efficient government of the Rebel states and to facilitate restoration."
