Military: Newton served in the Confederate Army as a Private in Company F of the 36th Tennessee Infantry. He enlisted in Cleveland, Tennessee on 12 Jan 1862.

Civilian: The 1870 U.S. Census recorded 32-year-old Newton and his 23-year-old wife Ann living in Denton County on a farm near Lewisville, along with their 1-year-old daughter Canzadia. By 1880 the Census showed that three more children had been born: John, Mary Ann, Nancy, and Cleda. By 1900 the family had added two daughters: Minnie and Trudie. Each Census recorded Newton's occupation as farmer.

Family: Newton was the son of John Howard Hayes and Elizabeth "Betsy" Gist. It appears from Census records that he was a twin to his brother Jasper Newton Hayes.
Newton married Ann Hall on 22 Jan 1868 in Monroe County, Kentucky.
