Military: Leslie served in the U.S. Army during WW I from 05 Mar 1918 until 19 Jun 1919. Leslie, along with 17 other young men from Union County, NM, left for Camp Funston in Kansas for their training for service overseas. He was a member of Company A, 360th Infantry, 90th Division with the rank of Private.

Civilian: On the 1930 Census, Leslie was recorded as working as a farmer at his home in Gladstone, NM. On his death certificate, Leslie's occupation was listed as painter.

Family: Leslie was one of ten children born to Dr. James Duncan Moorman and Belle McClain. He was married to Mary Evelyn Burdette. The couple had at least six children.
