Military: On 13 Nov 1861, William enlisted in the Confederate Army where he served in Co E, 5th Regiment, Tennessee Cavalry. His rank in was 1st Sgt and final rank was 1st Lieutenant.

Civilian: In the 1870 U.S. Census, the Wood family resided in Obion, TN, but by the time the 1880 U.S. Census was enumerated, the Woods family had relocated to Denton County, TX. On both census records William's occupation was listed as Farmer. Some sources show William's surname as Wood, others as Woods.

Family: William's parents were John Woods and Tennessee Mary Richey. William married Lucinda Elizabeth Chitwood on 6 Dec 1855 in Lincoln County, TN. Together their children were Mary Francis, James, Pleasant, Calvin, Emma, Kiona, and Harry, all of whom are also buried in Texas.
